Bethany Bloom, St. Walburg Facility manager, recalls at one point “having to share one vital signs monitor for all clinic patients, our 28-30 long term care patients as well as outpatients coming in for procedures.”

She explains that a “vital signs monitor provides blood pressure readings, pulse and oxygen saturation values. It is a very integral piece of equipment in our day to day operations and something we rely upon for accurate and timely patient care decisions.”

St. Walburg’s Order of the Royal Purple #201 are known for helping out in their community and this was no exception. On December 9th, the ladies presented a cheque to Twin Rivers Health Care Foundation in the amount of \$4,496.77 to cover the entire cost of the vital signs monitor. **Thank you, Royal Purple!**
